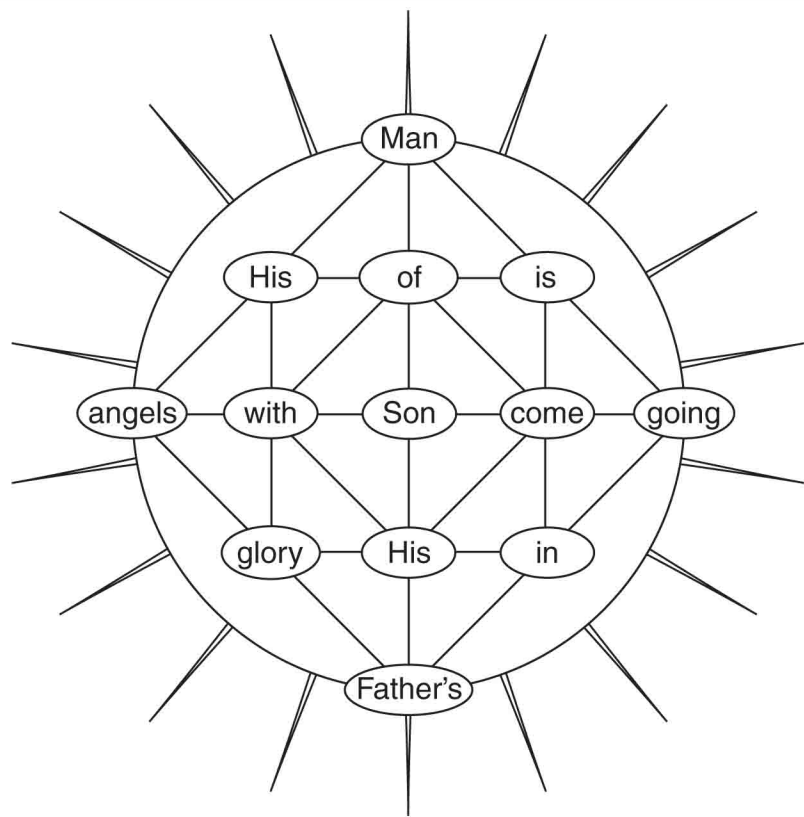


Jesus said the Son of Man was coming back. Find out what else He said.

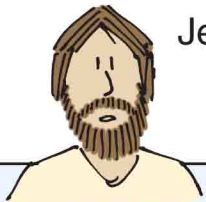
Jesus and His disciples were in Caesarea Philippi. Jesus told them that He must go somewhere else. Where did Jesus need to go?
