Morning Servant Sites:

Carter BloodCare (OSL campus)

Carter BloodCare is dedicated to giving life to the community. We provide life-saving blood components and transfusion services that give hope to people in need. OSL will be hosting a blood drive in our Fellowship Hall, 8:00am – 2:00pm.

Grace Bridge (Celina)

Grace Bridge is a volunteer-based organization equipping neighbors to help neighbors. Our goal is not to simply distribute food and other material goods, but to develop lasting relationships that over time will encourage those who receive help to return and help others.

Samaritan Inn (McKinney)

The Samaritan Inn is a comprehensive program that teaches self-sufficiency and life skills to meet the needs of individuals and families experiencing homelessness. We help willing people gain dignity and independence.

Hope Women's Center (McKinney)

Hope Women's Center is a non-profit medical clinic that guarantees a safe and non-judgmental atmosphere. Our goal is to provide women and teens with an education that ensures they can make empowering, well-informed decisions.

SoupMobile (OSL campus)

The SoupMobile is a 'mobile' soup kitchen that is a faith based non-profit charity that 'Feeds & Shelters' the homeless in Dallas. Our Mission Statement is three simple words spoken by Jesus more than 2,000 years ago: "FEED MY SHEEP."
