



LESSON 4 OVERVIEW

JESUS IS LIVING WATER

JOHN 4

Home Supplies needed:

- Bible
- 2 Plastic Cups
- Magic Slush powder that is in the ziplock baggie (Shh it's a surprise)
- Coloring sheet
- Water

Note to Parents/Guardians:

Before you start the lesson make sure to watch this video to prep for Object Lesson



OPENING

Share about a topic related to the lesson.

Supply: Bible

Welcome | Introduce the Lesson

Say: *Have you ever been thirsty? What was that like? Have you ever done something that you weren't proud of that you can talk about?*

Share

Tell kids an experience of both examples if comfortable sharing.



CORE BIBLE DISCOVERY

Use creativity to explore the Bible story and what it means to be made in God's image.

Say: *Wow, just like we talked about being thirsty. Did you know that Jesus is Living water? That his water never runs out just like his love for us!! Because Jesus is Living Water!*

Read John 4

As you read the passage about the woman at the well, let's remember how Jesus treated her. When we have sin in our lives, Jesus gives us love and forgiveness.

Say: *Jesus is Living Water! His love for us will never run out!*

Let's pray about that.

Pray: **Dear God, thank you for always loving and taking care of me. Just like water when we are thirsty you are always there for me. Help us to share about your love to others, Amen.**



OBJECT LESSON VIDEO

Share the object lesson with your child.

Demonstrate the Object Lesson to your child. Watch tutorial video listed above before demonstrating.

Suggestions for Parents/Guardians.

Start with pouring the water into each of the cups and talking about how the woman came to the well to draw water because she was thirsty. But as she talked to Jesus she realized He wasn't talking about the same water she was.

Jesus was talking about living water.

Then as you pour the water into the last cup (with the slush powder in it), and turn it upside down, you say "And living water meant she would never thirst again!"

Supplies

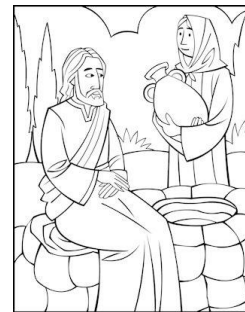
- Coloring Sheet
