

Resurrection Rolls

Reading with your child helps build language and thinking skills. We suggest you Share the Easter story.

Jesus - Marshmallow

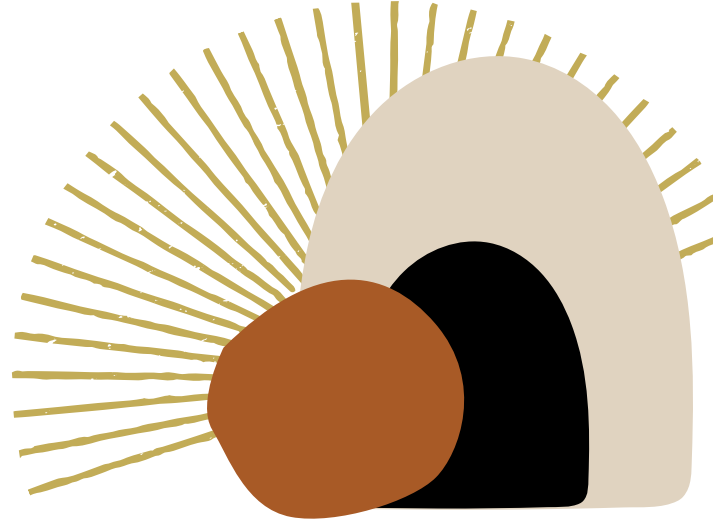
After Jesus died on the Cross he was wrapped in linen -

Roll marshmallow in butter and cinnamon

Jesus was put in the tomb - crescent roll dough

3rd day Jesus has risen and no longer in the tomb - open cooked roll to find no marshmallow

We hope you enjoy this activity with your children!



Gather ingredients:



Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Prepare (jumbo) muffin pan with non stick spray. Separate rolls into 8 triangles and combine sugar and cinnamon in a small bowl.

Dip each marshmallow into butter, then roll it in cinnamon-sugar and place on a triangle dough. Pinch around the edges of the marshmallow.

MAKE SURE YOU SEAL THE EDGES OR THE MARSHMALLOW WILL ESCAPE

Dip the tops of dough into the remaining butter and then into the cinnamon-sugar. Place the roll in the muffin tin sugar side up.

Bake at 375 degrees for 13-15 minutes. Eat Warm
